*No applicants are to leave the premises.

Applicant Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age
- Must have a high school diploma or GED
- Must attest they are physically able to do the work of an Ironworker, which may include:
 - Consistently lifting, up to 100 lbs.
 - Working outdoors and in a variety of weather conditions.
 - Working in an environment with strong odors and loud noises.
- Must pass a drug test at the expense of the sponsor, prior to enrollment.
- Must be able to work legally in the United States.
- Valid NY state driver's license
- Must have reliable transportation
